2.0 Announcements

The Four Credit Courses Policy was approved by the Faculty Senate on Nov 25, 2013. As part of the policy, it was determined that “In the Spring of 2016 the Curriculum Committee shall review the conversions of 3-credit courses to 4 credits and make whatever recommendations to the Senate it sees fit.”

At the CLASS meeting on 10/19/16, this policy was discussed with the following changes recommended:

1. We remove line 1, which removes the lapsed expiration date. The policy will now be permanent.
2. Fix the formatting and numbering to reduce confusion.
3. Suggested that what counts as a credit hour in federal law be more clearly stated. Suggests changing CFR to Code of Federal Regulations. Suggests adding this language: “Note: The Code of Federal Regulations is available from the U.S. Government Publishing Office at www.gpo.gov, through the Federal Digital System. The credit hour is defined in Title 34 – Education, §600.2 Definitions.
