Change in language to the Skill Area IV description

Current:

[PE 144](#) (College Wellness) is required of all students entering with fewer than 15 credits, and it is recommended that it be taken in the student's first year.

Proposed Language:

Students entering with fewer than 15 credits must take either [PE 144](#) (College Wellness) or CCSU 103 (Career Pathways). It is recommended that they be taken in the student's first year. CCSU 103 is only open to first semester first-year students.

3.0 Courses Deletion Policy

The curriculum committee is responsible for periodically reviewing courses that have not been offered recently. The bylaws are vague with respect to how this process should be handled and what to do. A committee made up of everyone who volunteered has been formed to establish a better procedure for archiving and returning classes to the catalog.

Problem: Students are frustrated when courses are listed in programs but not offered during their time at CCSU. NECHE requires we remove courses from the catalog if they are not offered in the last two years and are not on the schedule for the upcoming year. Our last report to NECHE erroneously stated that we remove courses after 4 years of inactivity. Our process has been to review courses not offered in four years, but to only remove courses if the department consents. 6% of courses have not run in the last two years. 13% have not run in at least four years. Deleted courses are too difficult to reanimate if a department chooses to offer them.

Stakeholders & goals

- Students – Clear and honest information about course options
- Faculty – Easily and quickly bring a course back if they believe that they can run it
- Registrar – Only update the catalog once a year
- NECHE – Courses should not be visible to students if they have not run in last two years and are not on the schedule for the upcoming year
- Deans – Retain the right to approve course offerings (this is in their contract)
