1.0 Announcements

- a. Website transition is coming this spring. The biggest change will be that IT will no longer support the current format of the agendas and minutes page. They are going to put everything in a sharepoint folder. Hopefully careful tagging of the files will allow us to find things when we need them.
- b. Course archiving – about 13% of all classes in the catalog have not been taught in at least two years. The problem is generally more acute for higher level classes. This is frustrating for students and violates NECHE guidelines. I think that there is a path towards making a system that works for everyone. We need an ad hoc committee to come up with a plan. Here are the constraints and goals as I understand them:

Problem: Students are frustrated when courses are listed in programs but not offered during their time at CCSU. NECHE requires we remove courses from the catalog if they are not offered in the last two years and are not on the schedule for the upcoming year. Our last report to NECHE erroneously stated that we remove courses after 4 years of inactivity. Our process has been to review courses not offered in four years, but to only remove courses if the department consents. 13% of courses have not run in the last two years. 6% have not run in at least four years.

Stakeholders & goals

- Students – Clear and honest information about course options
- Faculty – easily bring a course back quickly if they believe that they can run it
- Registrar – only update the catalog once a year
- NECHE – Courses should not be visible to students if they have not run in last two years and are not on the schedule for the upcoming year.
- Deans – Right to approve course offerings (this is in their contract)
