2) Exceptional Proposals

- a. Music Education, B.S. (Certifiable for PK-12 teaching) -- CHANGE PROGRAM

- i. MUS 101 (Practicum in Music Education), 1 credit -- CHANGE COURSE

This proposal reduces the number of credits, from 2 credits to 1 credit. This course covers topics related to issues in music education, observations and reflections on classroom teaching. Twelve hours of field experiences is required. Per the course description in Banner web-services, the course meets one hour per week during a sixteen-week semester. The balance of in-class and out-of-classroom work hours are in line with the recommended standard for a 1-hour course (the ratio is nearly 1:2). Based upon the number of classroom instruction hours plus out-of-classroom work hours, it is proposed the credit hours for this course be reduced from two to one.

The minimum total hours estimated for the course—classroom instruction hours (16) plus out-of-classroom hours (14) is 30.

- ii. MUS 310 (General Music Education), 3 credits -- CHANGE COURSE

The content of this course now consists of learning objectives and requirements of currently MUS 310 and MUS 311. Currently, the focus of MUS 310 is PK-4, while MUS 311 represents preparation to teach grades 5-12. The materials from both classes are now collapsed into one semester of learning. This class was last organized in this manner in 3004. It is our view that both courses can be collapsed into one while still effectively covering the necessary elements and demands of each course. This version of the course was in the program less than 20 years ago. We had the ability to accommodate extra credits then; however that no longer exists. No other comparable program offered 2 semesters of 3 credits for general music.

- iii. MUS 317 (Secondary Music Methods), 4 credits -- NEW COURSE

The content of this course combines learning objectives and requirements of existing courses MUS 315 and MUS 316. The focus of those courses represents preparation for teaching secondary choral and instrumental methods in a two-semester sequence. Out of necessity, the two courses have been merged and will be taught by both choral and instrumental professors. The materials from both classes are now collapsed into one semester of learning. This class was last organized in this manner in 2003. It is our view that both courses can be collapsed into one while still effectively covering the necessary elements and demands of each course.

- iv. MUS 390 (Orchestration), 3 credits -- CHANGE COURSE

Change of prerequisite course from MUS 222 (Music Theory IV) to MUS 319 (Chromatic Harmony II). This aligns with the proposed restructuring of our Music Theory sequence.

- b. General Education Skill Area 4 credit will be granted to students transferring "CCS 1001" from the community college. It was approved by the general education subcommittee and is listed here because it is the first new community college course we have considered, but thousands more are expected.
