

Faculty-Student Research Proposals, 2013-14

- 39 proposals received (31 in previous year).
- 34 awards made (27 in previous year).
- 65 student applicants (53 undergraduate, 12, graduate students, compared to 45 total applicants in previous year - 41 undergraduate, 4 graduate students).
- \$34,286 in requests (\$19,179 in requests in previous year).
- \$22,917 in awards) (\$13,609 in awards in previous year).
- An additional \$2,555 was awarded to three proposals, for 8 undergraduate students, through the Alumni Travel Fund.
- Funding summary:
26 awards, totaling \$17,635, were made to UG proposals from a total of 48 undergraduate student applicants.
8 awards, totaling \$5,282, were made to Graduate Student proposals from a total of 12 graduate student applicants.
- 2 Non-funded proposals:
(5 undergraduate applicants)
- \$15,000 available in new funding from the CCSU Foundation.
- \$13,921 carried forward in unspent funds from previous competitions.
- Abstracts are being collected for posting on the GFR website, at the Senate's request last year.
- In addition, GFR is running a separate, stand-alone summer faculty-student research competition, which has garnered 38 proposals with a total funding request of \$83,511.
