Proposal Regarding Date of Last Attendance and "FN" Grade

The following changes are proposed:

- (1) Any time that a student receives an "F" in a class, the instructor will be required to specify either the student's last date of attendance (if available) or the date of the last graded assignment.
- (2) If there is no record of the student's having attended the class (or in the case of a class in which attendance isn't taken, no record of work having been submitted; in the case of an online course, no record of having participated in any academically oriented activity in the class), the student would receive a grade of FN, a new grade indicating that the student never attended. A grade of FN will be treated as an "F" for GPA calculations.

Catalog language:

"An "FN" is a failing grade given to students who have no record of attendance and no record of academic participation for a course. It is treated as an "F" for GPA calculations."
