

### Proposal Regarding Date of Last Attendance and “FN” Grade

The following changes are proposed:

(1) Any time that a student receives an “F” in a class, the instructor will be required to specify either the student’s last date of attendance (if available) or the date of the last graded assignment.

(2) If there is no record of the student’s having attended the class (or in the case of a class in which attendance isn’t taken, no record of work having been submitted; in the case of an online course, no record of having participated in any academically oriented activity in the class), the student would receive a grade of FN, a new grade indicating that the student never attended. A grade of FN will be treated as an “F” for GPA calculations.

#### Catalog language:

“An “FN” is a failing grade given to students who have no record of attendance and no record of academic participation for a course. It is treated as an “F” for GPA calculations.”
