In my memo of April 19, 2006, I indicated that I was not approving establishment of the proposed courses in Mathematics Education Leadership until such time as a full proposal establishing a program in that field were to exist. To date, there has been no such fully vetted proposal that I have seen. The development of a new program should have the informed consent of the Deans of the Schools, the Provost, and the President. Before the University commits resources to a new program, issues such as need for the program and cost of the program must be established and the decision to move forward with the new program must be agreed upon and approved. To date, no such approval has been given. Therefore, it is incorrect to assume that the eight courses are approved. They are not.
