On January 30<sup>th</sup> Nick Tomaiuolo from the library presented a proposal to change the Grading Policy for the course, ***Library Resource Skills LSC 150***:

The Library faculty wishes to change the grading policy for this one credit course. Presently the course is graded Pass / Fail for all students enrolled in the course. It is requested that the grading policy for this course be revised so that students will be graded on the customary A B C D F scale. Our objective is to furnish students with a more detailed evaluation of their performance. This revision will facilitate that goal.
