b. Glynis Fitzgerald, Chair of the Graduate Studies Committee, moved the following resolution for the committee, which passed:

## Fresh Start Policy

"A student who has been admitted to a graduate program can independently or in conjunction with his or her Department initiate an appeal to the Dean of the School of Graduate Studies that includes a rationale as to why grades for graduate level courses taken seven or more years ago at CCSU that appear on the graduate transcript should not be used in calculating the student's GPA. Courses so omitted from the GPA calculation may not be used in the planned program in which the student is now enrolled. Each appeal will be decided on its own merits and students may use this option only one time."
