Committee on Academic Advising Report to Faculty Senate April 26, 2010

The Advisory Committee on Academic Advising was established by the Faculty Senate in the Fall of 2009 upon recommendation from the Ad Hoc committee for the Center for Student Success in its April 27, 2009 report to the Faculty Senate. Elections were held and additional members appointed in November 2009.

By-laws were developed in collaboration with the Committee on Committees and approved by the Faculty Senate at its March 8, 2010 meeting. The name of the committee was officially changed to Committee on Academic Advising (CAA).

Goals and objectives for student learning outcomes for academic advising were developed as a foundation for further work by the CAA. Transfer student advising and school-based centers were identified as priority issues.

We are planning to pilot a learning outcomes assessment of academic advising across the University in Fall 2010.

Recommendations:

- Properly resourced school-based advising centers to be established within each academic school based on the School of Business Model
- 2010 incoming transfer student advising to be coordinated by individual school Dean's Offices once the Spring 2010 semester is over. This function would move to school-based centers once they are established
