Mission: The Student Affairs Committee informs the faculty senate of new co-curricular interests of students. The Student Affairs Committee provides a forum through which student affairs may consult and inform faculty on student life areas, policy, and procedures. The aim is to gain faculty perspective and enhance faculty knowledge of student life initiatives and services.

## Membership:
