Senate Resolution

- Whereas, the Faculty has primary responsibility for the development and content of courses, curriculum, and programs of study, and for individual teaching assignments;
- Whereas, practica/internships and independent studies are an integral part of our academic curricula, programs of study, and University mission;
- Whereas, demands have been made on some departments 1) to reduce load credits given to faculty for supervising internships, and 2) to limit numbers of independent studies in a way that uses the assignment of load credits to shape our academic programs;
- Whereas, reductions will harm our students by limiting their educational and potential career opportunities; and
- Whereas, according to the principles of academic freedom and shared governance, the faculty has control over curriculum;

Resolved, that the Senate demands that the administration in practical internships on practical internships.

- 1) cease imposing limits on practica/internship and independent study load credits thereby shaping academic programs;
- 2) base its decision making about practica/internships and independent studies upon true collaborations with departments, past practice, sound educational principles, and shared governance;
- 3) communicate clearly and in a timely fashion to affected faculty about curricular issues; and
- 4) provide adequate resources to support CCSU's mission to prepare students to be thoughtful, responsible, and successful citizens, and in particular to support community engagement and independent study as a distinctive element of CCSU.
