DSA Committee 2011

A call for nominations to honor a CCSU faculty or staff member with the Distinguished Service Award was released on December 3, 2010, with a final closing date for nominations set for February 4, 2011. Six nominations were received by the closing date and the Distinguished Service Award Committee consisting of Mark Goldstein of the Psychology Department, Ioulia Kara-Soteriou of the Reading and Language Arts Department, Elizabeth Hicks of the Center for Advising & Career Exploration, Steven Kliger of the Center for Public Policy and Social Research, and Joseph Paige from Academic Affairs met to review the selection criteria and to be assigned a nominator(s) to contact and offer assistance in the completion of the dossier, which is the basis of evaluation. The deadline for having the completed dossiers submitted to the Provost's Office was April 1, 2011. Following that date, the DSA Committee began to review each submission individually. On April 18, 2011 the DSA Committee met to discuss their evaluations of each of the nominees and to deliberate their case for a candidate to be recommended to the President.
