

The Diversity Committee had a productive year and would like to highlight the following accomplishments:

Curriculum Sub Committee – Constructed application for D designation which faculty can use when applying for their course to be D designated. Also composed clear and detailed description of the D designation, including suggestions for how different disciplines and courses may integrate diversity into their courses. Both of these documents are available on the FSDC website.

Programming Sub Committee – Open student forum for Teacher Education students. Jacob Werblow took lead in raising funds and scheduling Civil Rights legend, Dr. Bernard Lafayette and Victoria Christgau for workshop for faculty and students on Kingian Nonviolence.

Policy Sub Committee - Equity study report will go to the President this week. Carolyn Fallahi reports that recommendations will be forthcoming with the release of the study. Carolyn's psy 236 course received a D designation (under curriculum).

Outreach Subcommittee – Brought in group of high school detention young women between 14 and 16 years old for a day at CCSU. This successful event allowed the young women to realize they can attend college. They attended a criminology class, received beneficial information about attending school from various departments. They were also treated to lunch and had some fun experiences built into their day.

Web Site Sub Committee – has again done a great job in keeping the FSDC informative and updated.
