

## Proposal to Reduce the Number of Credits Required for Graduation

The CCSU policy currently states that students must “complete a minimum of 122 or 130 credits, depending on one’s major”. The proposal is to change the policy to “complete a minimum of 120 to 130 credits, depending on one’s major”.

*Effective for students matriculating Fall 2015 or later, all programs that currently require a minimum of 122 credits for graduation will now require a minimum 120 credits for graduation.*
