<u>Language added to GSC bylaws on Term limits</u>: In order to formalize the GSC decision to opt out of the Senate rule of six year term limits for GSC members, the GSC added language to the bylaws related to term limits. The new bylaw will be inserted as bylaw II.5 Organization and Procedures, that reads:

"To ensure that all graduate programs are represented on the GSC, the GSC chooses to exempt itself from the Senate rule of members serving for the limit of six consecutive year term limits (Senate Bylaw 2.12.3)."
