He was also honored by the School of Engineering, Science, and Technology (SEST) as a 2015 recipient of the Dean's Outstanding Research Award. Dr. Hammad is an active member of The American Society of Mechanical Engineers (ASME), The American Institute of Aeronautics and Astronautics (AIAA), and The American Institute of Chemical Engineers (AIChE). For the past four years, Dr. Hammad has served as the Chair of the 'ASME Fluids Engineering Honors and Award Committee,' and is in his 2nd year with the executive committee of the ASME Fluids Engineering Division.
