- 4. Inclusion of items on the agenda of Senate to report on important questions before the UPBC which have university wide ramifications, or which result from gueries from Senators.
- 5. An annual, written report, by the Chair of the UPBC, on the activities of the UPBC and its recommendations to the President and to Senate. (to be presented for discussion at a meeting of Senate at the end of the Spring).
- 6. A report, vetted by the UPBC, each year from the Chief Admin Officer on the master plan, including upcoming renovations and buildings.
