PROPOSAL TO CHANGE

REQUIREMENTS FOR ADMISSION TO NURSING

Admission to the Nursing Program is highly competitive and meeting the following minimum criteria does not guarantee admission.

- 1. Acceptance to CCSU.
- 2. A minimum CCSU cumulative grade point average of 3.00.
- 3. A minimum overall cumulative grade point average of 3.00 for all coursework taken at all institutions, including CCSU.
- 4. Minimum grade of C+ in BMS 102/103 Introduction to Biomolecular Science lecture and laboratory, or equivalent.
- 5. Minimum grade of C+ in CHEM 161/162 General Chemistry I lecture and laboratory, or equivalent.
- 6. Minimum adjusted individual total score of 65.0% for the TEAS V test. This test may be taken up to two times.
- 7. In addition, the following conditions must be met:
 - a. Minimum grade of C+ in CHEM 210 Foundations of Organic Chemistry or equivalent:
 - b. Minimum grade of C in PSY 136 Life Span Development or equivalent; and
 - c. A grade of C+ or better in any additional required science courses, if completed.

Students will be ranked on the above criteria as follows: 25% overall GPA, 25% BMS 102/103 grades, 25% CHEM 161/162 grades, 25% TEAS V score.
