The following items were approved at the University Curriculum Committee meeting of February 14<sup>th</sup>, 2018.

1) Announcements:

- a. Proposal from Academic Standards; Approved in Curriculum: Effective for all students matriculating on or after Fall 2018 the residency requirement for earning a degree from CCSU are: a minimum of one-fourth of the total credits required for the undergraduate degree program must be completed in residence. **This includes at least 15 credits in the major (at least 12 of which must be at the 300 level or higher) and 9 credits in the minor for those students who are required to have or choose to have a minor.** For programs with no minor, the residency requirement is still 15 credits in the major. Programs in the School of Business require that at least 50% of the business credits needed for the business degree be earned and completed at Central Connecticut State University. In no case will a degree be granted unless a student is matriculated for a minimum of one year at the time of graduation. Any student has the option of completing the program requirements in effect during the catalog year when s/he entered the program or electing to abide by any new set of program or university requirements in a subsequent catalog year while the student remains in the program. Courses that do not carry Credits toward Graduation: ENG 099 and MATH 099. ENG 099 and MATH 099 are three-credit courses. The grade awarded will be computed into a student's GPA, but the credits will not count towards the number of credits required for graduation.
