Annual Report (2017-2018)

During the past academic year, the committee has been actively working on proposed changes to the *Academic Misconduct Policy* to better align with the *BOR Misconduct Policy*. Other committee activities included: examining the *Guide to Handling a Suspected Case of Academic Misconduct flow charts*, *Academic Misconduct Student Appeal form* and the *Academic Misconduct Report*. Specifically, the committee members reviewed the documents to identify any content that may be outlined more clearly for our academic community at large.

The committee also started brainstorming about how to educate and help faculty learn how the academic misconduct process works and why it's important to submit the necessary paperwork and work with the Student Conduct Office when there is suspected case of misconduct.

The goal for the next academic year is to present our recommendations to the faculty senate about the *Academic Misconduct Policy* and related documents. We also want to work closely with Dr. David Braverman, (Interim Assistant VP of Student Affairs) and finally, take the necessary steps to better inform the campus community of the academic misconduct process.

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
