Highlights:

- The primary activities for the 2021/2022 year were focused on redesigning the AIC website. After careful review it was determined that some information was either out of date, hard to navigate, or referenced obsolete documentation. Time was spent reviewing the current website, proposing changes to refresh the website look and feel, and updating all materials within. The first round of edits was sent over to the web development team in January of 2022 and a beta version of the website has been created. The AIC is currently in the process of making content changes which will be rolled out in time for Fall 2022. These changes will be sent to partners on the web development team for final update and launch.

- The AIC has partnered with the IT Committee and is participating in the process for evaluating software proposals for online exam proctoring. The Co-Chair of the AIC is as part of the review committee that will review proposals and determine finalists. At that point, other AIC members have volunteered to test the software in a sandbox environment. Members will spend 1-2 weeks trying out the software and providing feedback that will inform decisions.
