From the Senate Constitution:

3.6.1. The term of office for a voting Senator shall be two years. Vacancies shall be filled by the elected alternate for the remainder of the unexpired term and a new alternate shall be elected.

3.6.2. A voting member of the Faculty Senate may be elected for a total of three consecutive terms irrespective of the constituency represented.

NOTE: The number in parentheses is the number of consecutive years that the senator has been a member of the senate/committee, **NOT** including the current year. The Senate itself, and most committees, have a six-year limit for consecutive membership. Once the number in parentheses reaches 5, the person is in their 6th year of consecutive membership and cannot run for re-election unless they get an exception approved by the Senate.
